Streetlights

There are 10 Streetlights currently out. 7 in the village and 3 in parking lots or parkway. The majority of the long-term outages are due to bad underground wiring. The wires are being replaced and any new outages (old lights) are being reported to Village Management. We are also going to resurface the issue of shields for the new lights.

Auditorium Remodel

Work is continuing. The interior is gutted and ready for upgrade. The HVAC system has been replaced and is operating. The plumbers are installing updates to their systems to meet current code requirements. The last (hopefully) information requested by the county to complete the work permit has been provided. Cove Senior Management, the project manager, and contractor, continue to monitor the permit process. FYI, the outdoor kitchen is complete; however, the underwriter safety team will not let it be opened while other work is being done.
