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A message from the Board of Directors

There are still complaints about the functioning of the gates, both coming in and going out of the park. Both sets of gates have had new mechanisms installed. The key issue seems to be the misunderstanding of HOW they are supposed to function. There are signs and stickers on the bars instructing you to allow the car ahead of you to completely go through the gate before you follow. This is to avoid tailgating which may allow an unwelcome intruder from entering the property behind you.

To avoid damage to your car:

- 1. You must let the bar come down before you pass through the sensor. It does not store multiple scans. It accommodates one car at a time.
- 2. Likewise, when leaving the park, allow the gate to fully open before passing through to avoid the gate possibly hitting your car. Even if you are following someone out, stop to allow the gate to recognize another vehicle leaving.
