Our Communication Committee will have its first meeting later this month following the Board of Directors Reorganization. There will be some changes and improvements in our communication processes. Our website will be streamlined to allow for easier access to information. We will renew our efforts to get a web-based portal style system implemented by Village Ownership and Management. We may even update the style and/or format of the Insight. These are just a few of the items we plan to address, So, stand by.

Village Management Meetings (VMM)

In April, our monthly meetings with village management resumed. These meetings are scheduled to follow our HOA Informational Meetings each month. This allows us to request status and answers to questions about the most resent items brought to our attention. The most relevant items are presented at our next HOA meeting and the full report of the VMM is posted on our website.



After a bit of a delay your HOA and Village Management will begin taking soil samples from eight various yards within the village. The process requires 4 small samples to be taken from each tested yard from a depth of two to four inches below the surface. Sample yards will be selected at random and consist of good to poor lawn conditions. The samples will be sent to a laboratory used by the University of Florida Extension Service. Test results will be used to develop a soil amendment process used during the community re-sodding effort. The long team goal is to improve the life and condition of our lawns.
