Cleaning Up

Just a reminder. If you have debris from Idalia such as Tree Limbs or Palm Fronds in your yard. Please move them to the curb. There are two ways these items will be picked up. First is the Park Management Maintenance Team. They will be going around the village collecting. If you miss them, the second option is Waste Management Yard Waste Pick-up. If you use this option, you will most likely need to bundle the fronds and branches or chop them up and put in yard waste bags (paper or a container) for them to be picked up.

Trash, Recycling, and Yard Waste Pick-Up

Since there are many new Homeowners and residents in the village, it may be time to remind everyone that Waste Management, who provides our pick-up services, does so via a contract with Sarasota County. Not via any arrangement with the Village ownership. The taxes we pay via our lot rent provide for this service. Therefore, if you have an issue with a pick-up or have a question about service, you need to contact Weste Management directly. The Waste Management Phone is 941-355-9230 or WM.com. During Hurricane Idalia Status Notifications, some residents were confused about the area we are located in. Sarasota is divided between the **City** of Sarasota and Sarasota **County** "unincorporated". The Emergency Notifications in most cases apply to the entire County of Sarasota, including the city. However, sometimes you may hear the statement "in unincorporated Sarasota County." In all cases, this applies to Camelot Lakes Village since we are not in the city limits of Sarasota.
